HOP-ON HOP-OFF BUS: Visit the most popular attractions on a tour bus to have an overview of the city highlights including historic Gastown, Chinatown, Robson Street, Stanley Park, Granville Island Market and Yaletown. Price CA\$65. **Tickets and schedule times at the Concierge**

CAPILANO SUSPENSION BRIDGE & GROUSE MOUNTAIN TOP OF VANCOUVER

Visit the Capilano Suspension Bridge & Canyon, which is 450 feet across and 230 feet above the Capilano River. From there head to the top of Grouse Mountain on the skyride and experience the magnificent views of the city. Attractions include an alpine chalet, restaurants, gift shops, a theatre in the sky, grizzly bear viewing, the famous Lumberjack show and an open ice-arena (winter only). **Discount admission tickets for hotel guests at the Concierge desk.**

SEAPLANE SCENIC FLIGHT: For a unique experience, take a panoramic seaplane flight alongside the city skyline and the North Shore Mountains. YALETOWN: Vancouver's trendy district is known as the "hotspot" for restaurants, lounges, bistros & boutiques. This is an upscale neighborhood, where old warehouses have for made way to a wide array of shops and services. 5 minute walk

ROBSON STREET: For the people-watching, café-lounging and window shopping scene. Robson Street offers a variety of brand name stores, shops and boutiques. 15 minute walk.

GASTOWN: The colourful and cobblestoned historic heart of Vancouver. Visit the famous Steam clock, various antique stores, native art galleries, souvenir stores and sidewalk cafes, 20 minute walk.

STANLEY PARK: The park offers 1000 acres of natural beauty. See the world-class Vancouver Aquarium, the Klahowya Village, totem poles and the lost lagoon. Take a walk around the seven-mile world-renowned sea wall. Half miles from our hotel VIA the scenic oceanfront walkway. 15-minute taxi drive.

VANCOUVER AQUARIUM (in Stanley Park): This aquarium has over 20,000 sea creatures from all over the world, from the tropical seas to arctic waters. See the beluga whales, sea lions, otters, dolphins and sharks. 10 minute taxi drive.

CITY MUSEUMS: Museum of Anthropology, Vancouver Museum, Maritime Museum, and the Vancouver Art Gallery.

FLYOVER is a 4D flying theatre attraction; The pre-show sets the stage for the main attraction, it give guests an insider's look at the fascinating areas, people and cultures bringing each rider deeper into the FlyOver experience. WHALE WATCHING - April to mid-October

You have the opportunity to go whale watching and discover Orcas (Killer Whales) and other marine wildlife in their natural habitat. Capture the most amazing photos of the coastline and our wildlife. In addition to Orcas, you may see Minke whales, Gray whales, Elephant Seals, Sea Lions, Dolphins, Porpoises and Bald Eagles. Length is 3 to 5 hours. Price is CA\$189 per person including tax. CITY TOUR (3.5 hours)

You can take a daily guided city tour departing from our hotel lobby. VICTORIA & BUTCHART GARDENS (Full Day)
